These students were expertly guided by our teacher **Mr. Deepjyoti Das**. Apart from academics our students performed

1. For better comfort and concentration of our students of senior secondary class XII, we have provided them with Air Conditioning (AC) classrooms with white board facility. The classroom is in the top floor of our RCC building apart from the noise and disturbances for a serene and thoughtful environment fit for top level classroom teaching environment.
2. Recently, we have upgraded our computer lab with 20 new high configured, 6<sup>th</sup> Generation computer systems to meet the demand of present generation tech savvy child. The lab is also equipped with central line UPS which is capable of providing a continuous power back-up of 02 Hrs. in case of power failure during practical classes.
3. The upgradation of CCTV Camera setups in all the classrooms, corridors, playground, staircases, Main entrance etc. is also I think a remarkable

Development. 80 CM high megapixel bullet cameras on the corridors and playground are providing round the clock surveillance for any unprecedented incident.
